"RoHS III"— "Restriction of hazardous substances"

The EU-directions of the RoHS is not longer allowing various kinds of materials in electrical or electronic components. RoHS III directive (2015/863/EU) is an evolution of the original directive and became law on 22st July 2019.

Dangerous materials are:

Lead (Pb), Cadmium (Cd), Mercury (Hg), Hexavalent Chrome (Cr VI), Poly-Clorinated Liphenyls (PPB), Poly-Clorinated Diphenylether (PBDE), Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

All products produced by MULTI-BOX already fulfil the terms of RoHS regulations.
